

Summary of Changes

2020 Men's Competition

The KC Cup Advisory Council has been working with the Central Links Rules and Competitions Committee to review all aspects of the Men's KC Cup. The Advisory Council was made up of several 2019 captains and the following Central Links staff; Doug Habel-Executive Director, Todd C Stice-KC Cup Coordinator. The following changes were adopted by the Central Links Rules & Competitions Committee based upon the final recommendation of the Advisory Council.

Changes implemented for 2020

Chapman Alternate Shot match eliminated

This match will no longer be played.

Super Senior Handicap Four-ball match added

- A Four-ball match with both partners aged 60 years or older
- Match will be played at the designated handicap tees

KC Cup is now comprised of six handicapped matches and five scratch matches.

Handicap index on Singles matches increased

The maximum index per player in the Open and Senior handicap singles matches has increased from 7.0 to 9.0. If a player has an index over 9.0, they may play in this match but will be reduced to a 9.0 index.

Senior Professional tees adjusted

Senior (50+) professionals (as well as women professionals) shall play the handicap tees.

Playoff tiebreaker matches adjusted

With the elimination of the Alternate Shot match, the tiebreaking matches for a playoff round are in order:

1. Senior Scratch Singles
2. Open Scratch Singles
3. Handicap Four-ball match # 1

Professional/Amateur match position adjusted

The order of matches has been adjusted to have the professional / amateur match listed first in the order of play. This will allow the professional to return to the shop as soon as possible to attend to the Club's needs.

Women's eligibility updated

The requirements of women to be eligible to play in the KC Cup were updated in the Conditions of Competition to reflect the requirements are the same for women as men but are not eligible if a Women's KC Cup team has entered the women's competition.
