

Quarantine Quiz # 6

Live Review: Friday, May 1, 2:00 PM

All questions are stroke play with the Central Links Golf Hard Card unless noted.

Each question is asking for a specific score on the hole and the answer may also be disqualification.

1. Todd's tee shot comes to rest on the fringe on a blue paint dot the maintenance staff uses to create a mowing line for the putting green. The dot is in the general area. Todd marks the ball, lifts it cleans it and drops it in the right way on the fringe within one club length of the blue dot no nearer the hole. Todd chips the ball onto the green and holes the putt. What is Todd's score for the hole?
2. Doug's tee shot comes to rest in a greenside bunker on a drain. He lifts his ball to take free relief inside the bunker from the abnormal course condition. Before dropping, he determines the relief will leave a very difficult shot, so he changes his mind and drops in the right way outside of the bunker using the back-on-the-line relief procedure. He plays from there onto the green and holes the putt. What is Doug's score for the hole?
3. Taylor's is waiting to tee off her 13th hole. Without delaying play, she opens an app on her cell phone out and determines from the app the wind is blowing 20 MPH from the southwest. She then plays the hole in 4 strokes. What is Taylor's score for her 13th hole?
4. Jacque's tee shot comes to rest in the rough in bounds near the driving range. She makes a stroke at what she thought was her ball, but it turns out to be a part of a range that was cut in half by a mower. She then finds her original ball within the 3-minute search time. She plays onto the green and holes the putt. What is Jacque's score for the hole?
5. Nelson's tee shot comes to rest on a slope and on a sprinkler head. Without marking the ball, he lifts it to take relief. He correctly determines a relief area and drops in the right way, but the ball rolls out of the relief area. So, he drops again, and the ball rolls out of the relief area again. Now he attempts to place a ball on the spot of the second drop where it first struck the course, but it will not come to rest on the slope. So, he places a ball on the nearest spot in the general area where it will come to rest. This spot is 20 feet from the spot he originally tried to place the ball and obviously outside the relief area. He chips onto the green and holes the putt. What is Nelson's score for the hole?
6. Casey's tee shot comes to rest near but outside a No Play Zone defined as ground under repair. His backswing strikes a branch of a tree that is rooted in the GUR, but the branch is outside the edge of the GUR. He finishes the swing and the ball comes to rest on the green and he holes the putt. What is Casey's score for the hole?
7. Ryan's tee shot comes to rest in the fairway with a live insect on it. He removes the insect with his fingers and the ball does not move. He plays onto the green and holes the putt. What is Ryan's score for the hole?
8. Before teeing off Hole # 8, Todd asks Nelson, "Hey, # 4 is the same distance as # 8, what did you hit there?" Nelson says, "9-iron". Todd plays onto the green and holes the putt. What is Todd's score for Hole # 8?
9. Baile is in the teeing area ready to begin a hole. On the downswing, her driver head comes off the shaft, so she immediately stops her swing before the shaft reaches the ball. However, her separated clubhead hits the ground and bounces into her ball moving it forward 3 feet into the general area. She picks up the ball, re-tees it and plays it into the fairway. She plays from there onto the green and holes the putt. What is Baile's score for the hole?
10. Doug's tee shot comes to rest embedded in the lip of the side of the hole. About half the ball is below the surface of the ground and the ball is touching the flagstick. Doug lifts the ball, repairs the damage and tees off the next hole. What is Doug's score for the hole?
