

# Summary of Changes 2022 Men's Competition

---

The KC Cup Advisory Council has been working with the Central Links Golf Rules and Competitions Committee to review all aspects of the Men's KC Cup. The following changes were adopted by the Central Links Golf Rules & Competitions Committee based upon the final recommendation of the Advisory Council.

## **Changes implemented for 2022**

### **Divisional Selection**

All facilities are encouraged to form a four-team division with any facility in Kansas City, utilizing any criteria they see fit.

### **Round Options**

Each Round will have five options for play:

- 18 Players, 11 Matches (6 Net, 5 Gross) Default Option
- 14 Players, 9 Matches (6 Net, 3 Gross)
- 12 Players, 7 Matches (4 Net, 3 Gross)
- 10 Players, 6 Matches (3 Net, 3 Gross)
- 8 Players, 4 Matches (2 Net, 2 Gross)

Teams may agree to play any Round with any option. If an agreement is not in place, the 18-player default option shall be used. Standings will reflect overall win/loss percentage of matches played.

### **Scheduling of Rounds (One deadline)**

All six regular season rounds must be completed by August 7<sup>th</sup>, with no individual match deadlines. This option is in place to allow for more flexibility in scheduling rounds.

### **Female Professional Teeing Area**

Any female professional may play from a set of tees at any facility that is 85% the length of the Handicap tees for a round. The distance shall be determined hole-by-hole.
