Captains Expectations

- Work together to avoid conflicts, set starting times, etc.
- Respond Promptly on emails and calls
- Work out eligibility and handicap issues before a match
- Provide a fun competition at your home course
- Communicate with team members all KC Cup info

Division Procedures

We will draw for 3 divisions, two will contain four teams and one will contain three teams.

Division 1 and 2 will play each team twice during the regular season (1 home and 1 away) to comprise your 6 regular season matches.

Division 3 will play each team three times during the regular season to comprise your regular season matches. One team you will play twice home, one away, the other you will play one home, twice away.

Practice Rounds

- Practice rounds are not a requirement of the KC Cup
- Facilities are encouraged to allow practice rounds to foster the spirit of the competition.
- The fee is up to the host:
 - No Charge
 - Cart Fee
 - Discounted Rate
 - Full Rack Fee

Scheduling Procedures

- Captains and facilities are encouraged to schedule matches as soon as possible
- Three dates are offered to the visiting captain by the offering date
- The visiting captain must respond with the accepted date by the selection date
- The date agreed upon is sent to nelson@clgolf.org
- The match is played by the completion date
- **ALL MATCHES MUST BE COMPLETED BY JULY 31**

Playoff Schedule

- The three division winners and five wildcards will make the field of eight for the playoffs
- The quarterfinals and semifinals are played as a home and away series, with the championship a single match at a neutral site to be determined
- Championship date tentatively set for October 2 (neutral site TBD by Central Links Golf)

Match Procedures - Lineups

- Visiting Captain Must provide home captain with lineup no later than 24 hours before the scheduled time of the match
- The home captain will then exchange their lineup in a reasonable time with the visiting captain
- Changes to a lineup cannot be made once the lineups have been exchanged
- Changes can be made if there is a good reason such as:
 - Work Conflict
 - Injury
 - Family emergency, etc.....

Match Procedures - Play

- The way a match is played can be agreed upon by both captains, shotgun, tee times, order and time of matches, etc...
- Low handicap Four-ball match with a maximum of 4 strokes per player given
- Mid-handicap Four-ball match with a maximum index of 18.1 per player
- High handicap Four-ball match with a maximum index of 26.0 per player
- Handicaps, course ratings and hole allocations are used from the GHIN system

Match Procedures - Play

- The committee in charge of the competition is the onsite professional staff.
- If the staff is unavailable or cannot make a decision, then Nelson Searcy may be contacted for the decision.
- All Local Rules of the Host Facility are in effect
- All matches are governed by the Rules of Golf and the Conditions of Competition

Match Procedures – Posting Scores

- Players must post scores on the date of the match
- Captains are responsible for scores being posted
- If you play all 18 holes, post score as normal.
- If you play 10-17 holes, please post using this scoring option that is available in GHIN. For example, if your match ends after the 13th hole, post your score for holes 1-13 and leave 14-18 blank. The GHIN system will do the rest for you.

Match Procedures – Results

- Both Captains must return COMPLETED results spreadsheet (Inside 48 hours of match completion)
- Ensure that:
 - Individual Player's gross scores are listed on the report
 - The side who wins the match gets the 1 point
 - Final Score of the Match (3&2 or Tied)
 - Electronic signature to confirm results
